

Newspaper Project

Congratulations! You were just named editor of a Coketown newspaper. It is your job to create a newspaper that reports on the events and information of Charles Dickens's *Hard Times*. Projects must be formatted like newspapers, printed, and turned in during class on March 10th. All newspapers must include:

- The name of your newspaper and date
- At least three articles
- At least two pictures
- At least two extras like advertisements, wedding announcements, obituaries, editorials, ect.
- Proper grammar and mechanics

An "A" project creatively addresses the text with little or no errors, has good formatting, exceeds requirements, and demonstrates a good understanding of the text.

A "C" project has adequately accomplished the bare minimum of requirements, attempts newspaper formatting, has a couple noticeable errors in grammar and/or facts from the book, and shows a decent understanding of the text.

A "F" project has many errors, does not attempt to format, fails to meet at least two of the requirements listed, and displays a lack of understanding of the text.
